Annual Affiliation Fees Breakdown

Each year, in addition to your club membership fees, every golfer in Cheshire pays a **county affiliation fee** – two thirds of this fee is then passed on to **England Golf** on your behalf.

So, what do you get for this contribution? Below is a brief outline of the benefits you receive as a registered member of your club, through your affiliation with both Cheshire Golf Limited (CGL) and England Golf.

England Golf

- Provides and manages your WHS Handicap Index, ensuring you can play and compete anywhere.
- Includes **personal liability insurance** of up to **£10 million** for all members.
- Offers exclusive member benefits through partnerships such as Your Golf Travel.
- Organises national teams and championships for all levels Men, Ladies, Seniors, and Juniors — supporting both elite and club golfers.
- Supports clubs through a nationwide network of Club and County Support Officers, offering guidance and resources.
- Ensures every affiliated club adopts robust **Safeguarding** and **Equality, Diversity & Inclusion** (**ED&I**) policies.
- Operates the National Golf Centre at Woodhall Spa, with member discounts available to all England Golf club members.
- Delivers a range of workshops and development programmes to help clubs and volunteers grow the game.

Cheshire Golf

- Organises a wide range of tournaments and championships for all abilities from elite
 players to those with higher handicaps including the popular Cheshire Handicap Trophy.
- Runs county teams across all age groups and categories Men, Seniors, Boys (U18, U16, U14), Women, Senior Women, and Girls competing in inter-county and national events.
- Provides **first-class coaching** for all Cheshire squads and **development coaching** for young players aged ten and above.

- Funds and supports **programmes to attract new golfers** and **initiatives for golfers with disabilities**, promoting inclusion and growth.
- Offers club engagement and support through annual Cheshire Golf Roadshows, covering topics such as the Rules of Golf, Handicapping, WHS, Course Rating, Sustainability, and more including specialist WHS workshops.
- Maintains the highest standards of safeguarding for all volunteers involved in junior golf.
- Oversees and funds the Course Rating programme across the county.
- Hosts Rules of Golf evenings led by R&A-qualified Cheshire referees and encourages the sharing of knowledge between clubs through the County Office.
- Employs a dedicated **County Secretary** who manages the day-to-day running of the county and maintains strong relationships with club managers and secretaries.
- Operates the County Card Scheme, free to all affiliated Cheshire members, and offers the
 opportunity to join the Life Members Scheme (£25 fee) to enter exclusive Life Member
 events throughout the season.
